In-person Service Guidelines
February 2021

We are pleased to have you join us for in-person services at Calvary. Our service time is 11:00 a.m. on Sundays, beginning February 21, 2021. We ask those attending to please comply with our local city requirements for indoor in-person gatherings.

See the list below for basic guidelines and services offered. The doors will open at 10:30 a.m. for temperature checks and COVID-19 screening. Plan to arrive early so that you are seated for the 11:00 a.m. service.

By attending, you are agreeing to the following:

General Expectations:

- Facemasks are always to be worn and must cover your nose and mouth, except when participating in communion. Facemasks will be available at the front door if you fail to bring your own.
 - o Children under 2-years of age are not required to wear a mask.
 - o If you are unable to or unwilling to wear a mask while attending our indoor service, we ask that you participate by watching the online video or livestream instead of attending services.
- Observe social distancing when walking, standing, and sitting.
- No congregating indoors or outdoors before or after the service.
- No use of church facilities except the provided restrooms, elevator, and auditorium.
- Follow the directions of ushers regarding seating.
- No singing.
- Use of restrooms by one individual or one family at a time.
- COVID-19 screening questioning and checking of temperature before entering the facility. Individuals answering affirmative to any COVID-19 questions or registering a temperature above 100.3 degrees will not be permitted to enter the facility.
- Register your name upon entry for contact tracing purposes. Documents will be destroyed after three weeks.
- Hand sanitizer will be readily available upon entry and exit of the facility.

Arrival at Church: Screening will begin at 10:30 a.m. Please do not wait until 11 a.m. to arrive since the service will begin promptly at 11 a.m.

- Step 1: Entry. Proceed to the courtyard entry. **Please do not enter the facility through any other doorway.**
- Step 2: Check-in and Screening. Que at the check-in stations for your COVID-19 Screening. Be sure to maintain safe social distancing and keep facemasks on while waiting in line.
- Step 3: Temperature Check and Registration. Once the screening is cleared you will be directed to the glass doors for temperature checks and registration.
- Step 4: Seating. Proceed upstairs to the auditorium entrance where an usher will seat you. (The elevator will be accessible as needed for guests.) All families and members of the same household

are requested to sit in the same pew. Due to sanitization requirements, please do not change seating location after the usher seats you.

- Please greet others from your seated location and continue maintaining safe, social distancing.

Church Service: Plan to arrive early to be screened and seated. Service will begin promptly at 11 a.m.

- 11:00 Start of Service (message will be given shortly after the welcome)
- 12:00 Dismissal by rows

Dismissal from Church:

- At the end of the service, we will dismiss in an organized manner that allows for safe social distancing.
 - o Please pick up any trash that is in your seating area.
 - o Ushers will dismiss by row. Please wait until the usher dismisses your row before departing.
 - o Offering boxes will be available at the back of the auditorium. We do encourage you to continue using online giving for regular offerings, missions giving, and love offerings.
 - o Please remember that we are not to be congregating inside or outside.
 - o Please access the hand sanitizer as you depart.

We will not be offering the following at this time:

- Coffee, beverages, or food
- Nursery or childcare
- Bulletins
- Children's services
- Singing
- Passing of offering plates
- Passing of communion trays
- Areas or rooms for childcare, nursing, child supervision, etc.

Restroom Use:

- Only the Ladies and Men's restrooms downstairs near the elevator will be accessible for those attending the service.
- Restrooms will be available for an individual or family members from the same household at the same time.
- Please observe safe social distancing while waiting in line for bathrooms.
- Be sure to wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- Please follow the instructions of the restroom attendants.
- Restrooms will be stocked and sanitized throughout the morning.
